The Coming of Jesus as "Fulfillment"

Fulfilled in Jesus

What did Jesus fulfill?

- Prophecy verbal propositions predicting the coming of a deliverer-king
- Typology people, events, structures that foreshadow the person and work of Jesus

Jesus fulfills the storyline of the Bible expressed in God's promise to Abraham

Fulfilled in Jesus

Matthew 1-2

- 1. Genealogy: Son of Abraham
 - Jesus is the "seed" in whom the promises to Abraham would ultimately be fulfilled

Fulfilled in Jesus

Matthew 1-2

- 2. Miraculous Birth
 - Jesus is the unique, "Isaac-like" son of promise
 - Jesus is the unique Son of God ("Emmanuel")

Fulfilled in Jesus

Matthew 1-2

- 3. Worship of the Magi
 - Anticipated the salvation/blessing of the nations through the seed of Abraham (Gen. 22:18)

Fulfilled in Jesus

Matthew 1-2

- 4. Sojourn in Egypt
 - Jesus' movements re-enact Israel's sojourn in and exodus from Egypt ("fulfills" Hosea 11:1)
 - Jesus, as God's Son, is the true Israel sums up the people of God in Himself

Fulfilled in Jesus

Matthew 1-2

5. Preservation from Herod's Massacre

- Jesus is a Moses-like deliverer whom God preserved
- The weeping of exile is "fulfilled" (climaxed and ended) because the Deliverer is here

Fulfilled in Jesus

Additional: Matthew 4:1-11

- > Temptation in the Wilderness
 - Jesus repeated the kind of testing that Israel faced during the 40 years in the wilderness
 - Whereas the national "son" failed, the true Son (true Israel) obeys and triumphs

Fulfilled in Jesus

Significance: Good News!

- > Through faith in Jesus, we are the seed of Abraham, heirs of the promise
- Gentiles are full members of the people of God we are "sons of God"
- Jesus, by spiritual union with Him, is our perfect representative His obedience is ours!
