- > Essence of a neighbor who loves
 - 1. Heart of Compassion
 - sees and responds to those who are in need
 - overcomes natural prejudice or resentment

Biblical Response

Luke 10:25-37

- > Essence of a neighbor who loves
 - 2. Hands of Compassion
 - willingly to be inconvenienced
 - willingly to give and sacrifice
 - willingly to go beyond the minimum

Biblical Response

- 3. Support HPC with your finances and time
