God's Creation Purpose


Psalm 8:1-9

- 1. The display of God's majestic name
 - displayed in God's creating man in His image and giving man dominion over all creation
 - as God's image-bearer, man is to rule and subdue creation and fill the earth

God's Creation Purpose

Psalm 8:1-9

- 2. The Problem
 - Man rebelled against God, failed to rule, and fell under God's judgment
 - Man is now subjected to death and all of creation is subjected to corruption




Fulfillment in Christ

A. Jesus' Humiliation

> Hebrews 2:5-9

- *His incarnation* Jesus, the eternal Son, took on a human nature and was subjected to death
- His death Jesus became man in order to remove God's judgment from us by "tasting death" for us




Fulfillment in Christ

B. Jesus' Exaltation

- > 1 Corinthians 15:20-28
- 2. Jesus' resurrection is the "first fruits"
 - His resurrection is the guarantee of the bodily resurrection of all who belong to Him
 - The resurrection of believers will happen at Christ's coming

Fulfillment in Christ

- B. Jesus' Exaltation
- > 1 Corinthians 15:20-28
- 3. Jesus reigns as the exalted Son of Man
- On the basis of His redeeming work, Jesus is given dominion over all things as Man
- · the last enemy that will be abolished is death



- bringing the Father glory
- The goal of all history and creation is that God be all in all
