Overview

- 1. Theme: "kingdom of heaven"
 - a description of the lifestyle of those who belong to the kingdom of heaven
 - a description of living the kingdom life in a fallen, hostile world

Sermon on the Mount

Overview

- 2. Purpose: discipleship
 - a call to a radical, counter-cultural lifestyle that is distinct from the pagan and religious world
 - a warning and invitation to those who have not entered the kingdom

Sermon on the Mount

The Foundation: "the beatitudes"

- Overview
 - the beatitudes are descriptions (not commands) of the essential characteristics of those who possess the kingdom of heaven

Sermon on the Mount

The Foundation: "the beatitudes"

- ➤ Overview
 - the beatitudes are pronouncements of "blessing" upon those with these characteristics ("fortunate", "well is their world")

Sermon on the Mount

The Foundation: "the beatitudes"

- ➤ Overview
 - the beatitudes are both counter-intuitive and radically counter-cultural

Sermon on the Mount

The Foundation: "the beatitudes"

- ➤ Chief Characteristic: "poor in spirit"
 - 1. Meaning
 - the personal acknowledgment of spiritual bankruptcy before God
 - opposite of self-righteousness, self-reliance, self-importance

The Foundation: "the beatitudes"

- ➤ Chief Characteristic: "poor in spirit"
 - 2. Implications
 - we do not have the spiritual resources in ourselves to put into practice the Sermon on the Mount
 - possessing the kingdom of heaven and living a kingdom lifestyle is all the work of God's grace
