Persecution Today...

- 200 million Christians in 60 countries face overt persecution every day
- More Christians (26 million) were martyred in the 20th century than in the previous 19 centuries combined
- 150,000 to 165,000 Christians are martyred every year

The Witness of the Kingdom

1. Goal of our Lifestyle

- > that others may glorify God (5:16)
 - live in such a way that people look at your life and make much of God
 - this goal in our actions is an expression of greatest love for others

The Witness of the Kingdom

1. Goal of our Lifestyle

- Q: What kind of life causes others to glorify God when they see it?
- A: A life that can only be explained by a love for God and an unshakable hope in His kingdom

The Witness of the Kingdom

2. Effects of our Lifestyle

- Persecution
 - our righteousness will be contrary to the values of the world and will meet with opposition
 - our incomparable reward in heaven is the source of present joy in persecution

The Witness of the Kingdom

2. Effects of our Lifestyle

Revelation

- "salt of the earth" we give a savor of God in an insipid, godless world
- *"light of the world"* we shine the knowledge of God into a spiritually dark world

The Witness of the Kingdom

3. Display of our Lifestyle

- > Complementary Features:
 - distinctiveness if our life is diluted so as to be indistinguishable from the world we are useless as a witness of the kingdom
 - involvement if our life is isolated and withdrawn from the world we are useless as a witness of the kingdom
