Discontinuity

1. Relationship of God and the creation

- A. Nature of God
 - Myths: pagan gods are personifying cosmic spaces or forces of nature; they were begotten
 - Genesis: Yahweh is before, separate from and above His creation
- B. Nature of created materials
 - Myths: animate forces (gods)
 - Genesis: inanimate material; created by command of God; under His dominion

2. Relationship to other gods

- Myths: describe creation as cosmic struggle between gods
- Genesis: Yahweh is the only god; no struggle, no lesser forces

Discontinuity (con't)

3. Creation of man

- Myths: man is an afterthought; relieve the gods of work and provide them with food
- Genesis: man is the pinnacle of creation; created in image of God; creation a gift for man (has dominion)

4. Nature and style of the literature

- Myths: very fanciful, dramatic poetry of cosmic struggle between gods
- Genesis: very straightforward, descriptive account given in elevated prose
