Jesus and the Gospels

- 1. Jesus is the incarnate Son He was a man
 - ➤ Luke 1:26-35
 - His maleness is necessary to His mission as King, Savior, Priest, Son of Man, the second Adam
 - He embodies true manhood saving, protecting, leading, ruling, teaching and serving

Jesus and the Gospels

- 2. Jesus appointed 12 apostles they were men
 - > Luke 6:12-16
 - He chose and prepared them for roles as official leaders of the new messianic community
 - they would lead this mission, teach with special revelation, give direction to the church, and care for the sheep like shepherds

Jesus and the Gospels

- 3. Jesus highly valued women they were disciples
 - a) Jesus ministered to women
 - widow at Nain (7:11-17)
 - anointing by the "sinful" woman (7:36-50)
 - woman with a hemorrhage (8:43-48)
 - woman crippled for 18 yrs. (13:10-17)

Jesus and the Gospels

- 3. Jesus highly valued women they were disciples
 - b) Jesus included women in His ministry
 - women supported Jesus' ministry (8:1-3)
 - women were learners from Jesus (10:38-42)
 - women were the first witnesses of the resurrection of Jesus (24:1-11)
