What is in a Name?

- in Hebrew names were common nouns and verbs (e.g. "Isaac")
- names reveal meaning, character, essence, personality

The most important name in the Bible: God's Name!

The Name of God

Context:

- > God's response to His people's cry
 - He heard, remembered, saw, knew
 - He "came down"
 - He promised: "I will be with you"

Reveals God's "relatedness" to His people

The Name of God

Moses' Question:

- 1) He was asking about the essence of God's character and nature
- 2) While God has many descriptive titles, He has but one name
- 3) This name was used prior to Moses, but its meaning is now being revealed

The Name of God

God's Answer:

- 1. 'EHYEH
 - "I AM who I AM";
 - "I AM has sent me to you"
- 2. YAHWEH
 - "The LORD...has sent me to you"

The Name of God

- 1. Hebrew Root Word: היה *(HaYaH)* = "to be"
- 2. 1st Person Impf. Sing. of *hayah*
 - אה'ה ('eHYeH) = "I am/will be"
- 3. 3rd Person Impf. Sing. of *hayah* יהוה (*YaHWeH*) = "He is/will be"

The Name of God

"Yahweh" (YHWH) is God's Name

➤ meaning = "He is" or "He will be"

"Jehovah" (a hybrid word)

- same Hebrew letters: YHWH (JHVH)
- vowels for "adonai"
- not a Hebrew word

The Name of God

The Significance:

- 1. God's absolute existence
 - self-existent not determined or caused by anything outside Himself
 - eternal no beginning or end ("the One who always is")

Everything derives its being and meaning from Him!

The Name of God

The Significance:

- 2. God's active existence
 - "I will be" points to His relatedness to His own people
 - His eternal existence is related to His covenant faithfulness for our good

Yahweh is God's covenant/memorial name

The Name of God

Forward-Directed: Jesus

- 1. Jesus (Yeshua) "Yahweh saves"
 - Jesus is the fullest expression of the meaning of Yahweh
 - He is the coming down of God to provide ultimate deliverance for His people

Forward-Directed: Jesus

2. Jesus' Own Claim

"Truly, truly, I say to you, before Abraham was born, I AM." (John 8:58)
