## Numbers 11-25

### **Overarching Lesson**

- > Take heed, lest you fall!
- Beware of an evil heart of unbelief in the midst of great knowledge of God
- Beware of being hardened by the deceitfulness of sin and not holding fast to Christ until the end

## **Murmurings & Rebellion**

#### Numbers 11:10-34

- The people's actions were a rejection of the Lord
- The Lord demonstrated His power by providing in one instance more than enough meat
- The Lord struck the people with a severe plague the "graves of greediness"

## **Murmurings & Rebellion**

#### Lessons

- 1. Warning: do not crave evil things
- Beware of grumbling
- Beware of greed
- Beware of envying the wicked
- Beware of despising the Lord's provision
- Beware of becoming accustomed to grace
- Beware of losing sight of the reward

## **Murmurings & Rebellion**

#### Lessons

- 2. Encouragement: necessity of the wilderness
  - > Deuteronomy 8:1-17
    - Adversity is designed by God to test and reveal the nature of our faith
    - Adversity is designed by God to humble us, remove self-reliance and make us dependent on Him
