
# Gleanings from the Pentateuch

### In the Wilderness

- 1. Waters of Marah
  - Object lesson: God's "torah" will be sweet and satisfying to them
  - Test: will they trust that His statues are for their good?

#### In the Wilderness

- 2. Bread from Heaven
- > testing: will they follow His "torah"?
  - Gather only enough for one day
  - Do not gather on the Sabbath

### In the Wilderness

- 2. Bread from Heaven
- > lessons
  - Trust in God's provision ("manna")
  - · Disobedience profits nothing
  - Obedience brings blessing

# In the Wilderness

- 3. Water from the Rock
- God's power is for them to provide and satisfy them
- Miraculous provision most unlikely place to get water

# In the Wilderness

#### **God's Purpose**

- 1. To make them deeply conscious of their total dependence on God
- 2. To teach them that following His instructions brings life and satisfaction

# In the Wilderness

#### **Deuteronomy 8:1-17**

- > God's stated purpose
  - to make them understand that man lives by everything that proceeds out of the mouth of the Lord
  - To humble them and test them for their good by removing all self-reliance
