



Refinement of Jacob

In Haran (20 yrs.):

- 2. Jacob deceived Laban
 - Shrewdly used a clever gimmick to obtain Laban's livestock
 - · Secretly fled from Laban

God kept His promise, protected Jacob and richly blessed him



Refinement of Jacob

Jacob's Encounter with God

- > Setting: Impending meeting with Esau
 - Jacob was "greatly afraid and distressed"
 - He prayed to God based on His previous promise (sign of growth in faith)
 - He contrived a plan that would hopefully appease his brother

Refinement of Jacob

Jacob's Encounter with God

- > A man wrestles with Jacob
- the unknown man initiated the attack
- the man's identity was concealed (dark) but was slowly revealed as divine
- Jacob became aware of the man's divine character and desired a blessing

Refinement of Jacob

Jacob's Encounter with God

- > Significance
- A. The encounter
 - the wrestling is indicative of Jacob's whole life (self-reliant struggle for blessing)
 - he was brought to a point of clinging to the man for blessing (dependence on God)

Refinement of Jacob

Jacob's Encounter with God

- > Significance
 - B. The change of name
 - From "Jacob" signified his self-reliant
 - To "Israel" signified that he prevailed in his striving with God

Refinement of Jacob

Jacob's Encounter with God

- > Meeting with Esau
 - All of Jacob's elaborate preparations for appeasing Esau were unnecessary
 - God had prepared the way by changing Esau's disposition

Refinement of Jacob

Lessons

- 1. God desires our complete dependence on Him and will "fight us" to have it
- 2. "Cease striving" lay aside anxiety, fear, and worry; trust in the promises and providence of God
