#### **Heart Attitudes**

Worship is essentially an issue of the heart not outward form

Strong affections for God, rooted in and fueled by the truth of God, is the heart of biblical worship

#### **Spiritual Affections**

- 1. Love for God
  - "love is the first and chief of the affections, and the fountain of all the affections" (J. Edwards)

#### **Heart Attitudes**

#### Matthew 22:36-38

- 36) "Teacher, which is the great commandment in the Law?"
- 37) And He said to them, "YOU SHALL <u>LOVE</u> THE LORD YOUR GOD WITH ALL YOU HEART, AND WITH ALL YOUR SOUL, AND WITH ALL YOUR MIND.
- 38) This is the great and foremost commandment."

- 2. Reverence and Awe ("fear")
  - "...let us have gratitude, by which we may offer to God an acceptable worship with reverence and awe; for our God is a consuming fire." (Hebrews 12:28-29)

- 3. Gratitude (Col. 3:16-17)

- 5. Hope (Psalm 42:5; 33:18)
- 6. Brokenness (Ps. 51:17; Is. 66:2)
- 7. Satisfaction (Psalm 63:5)
- 8. Desire/Longing (Psalm 42:1-2; 63:1)

# **Heart Attitudes**

#### **Kindling the Affections**

- 1. Repent of your coldness
- 2. Ask for specific, godly affections
- 3. Fix your mind on a biblical truth/promise
- 4. Act outwardly in obedience

## **Heart Attitudes**

#### Philippians 4:6-9

- 6) Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God.
- 7) And the peace of God, which surpasses all comprehension, shall guard your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus.
- 8) Finally brethren, whatever is true...let your mind dwell on these things.
