Origins of Jesus

Jesus' Birth (1:18-25)

- 1. The Role of Joseph
 - His character a genuine righteousness, a remarkable faith, an immediate obedience
 - His importance it is through his actions that Jesus becomes the legal "son of David"

Origins of Jesus

Jesus' Birth (1:18-25)

- 2. Jesus' Miraculous Conception
 - a) His conception was the direct product of the creative work of the Holy Spirit
- > Why?
 - A sign of God's miraculous provision
 - Evidence that while Jesus is fully man, yet He is the unique Son of God

Jesus' Birth (1:18-25)

- 2. Jesus' Miraculous Conception
 - b) It was the fulfillment of Isaiah 7:14
 - miraculous sign from God the birth by a virgin of a son who would be the deliverer of God's people
 - Jesus is uniquely "Immanuel" God with us

Origins of Jesus

Jesus' Birth (1:18-25)

- 3. The Purpose of Jesus' Coming
- > To save His people from their sins
 - The name "Jesus" (Yeshua) = Yahweh saves; Jesus, as Yahweh, saves His people
 - "from their sins" not from political subjection but alienation from God because of sin
