Matthew 8:18-22

Now when Jesus saw a crowd around Him, He gave orders to depart to the other side. And a certain scribe came and said to Him, "Teacher, I will follow You wherever You go." And Jesus said to him, "The foxes have holes, and the birds of the air have nests; but the Son of Man has nowhere to lay His head."

Matthew 8:18-22

And another of the disciples said to Him, "Lord, permit me first to go and bury my Father." But Jesus said to him, "Follow me; and allow the dead to bury their own dead."

Jesus' Authoritative Call

A. The Meaning of His Call

- > two things are implied...
 - submitting in faith and practice to Jesus as Savior and Lord
 - joining Him in the work He was sent to do "to seek and save the lost"

Jesus' Authoritative Call

B. The Nature of His Call

- 1. It is a costly call
 - following Jesus is a call to relinquish temporal comforts and convenience
 - following Jesus is a call to hardships, hatred, sacrifice, suffering

Jesus' Authoritative Call

- B. The Nature of His Call
 - 2. It is an exclusive call
 - even the closest family ties must not be set above or hinder allegiance to Jesus
 - the overriding priority of the disciple of Jesus is the life of the kingdom
