Jesus' True Family

A. Meaning

- > "my brothers and sisters and mother"
 - His disciples are the most beloved and dearest to Him, even beyond His natural family



Jesus' True Family

A. Meaning

- > "my brothers and sisters and mother"
 - He entered into earthly kinship to bring us into a vastly superior, more satisfying relationship with Himself and His Father



Jesus' True Family

B. Implications

- 1. Relationship to Jesus is our most important relationship, even beyond family
- 2. In Christ we are brought into a relationship with one another that is more fundamental than our natural family
