A. Present Nature of the Kingdom

- 1. Parable of the Tares
 - the kingdom of God will be contested by and co-exist with the kingdom Satan until the end of the age

Parables of the Kingdom

A. Present Nature of the Kingdom

- 2. Parable of the Mustard Seed
 - though it has small, imperceptible beginnings, the kingdom of heaven will grow and reach its triumphant fulfillment

A. Present Nature of the Kingdom

- 3. Parable of the Leaven
 - though it has small beginnings, the kingdom of heaven has a permeating, transforming effect that will result in its future glory

 - "so shall it be at the end of the age"
 - all sons of the evil one will be removed and cast into fiery judgment
 - the righteous will be glorified and the kingdom of Christ will fill the earth
