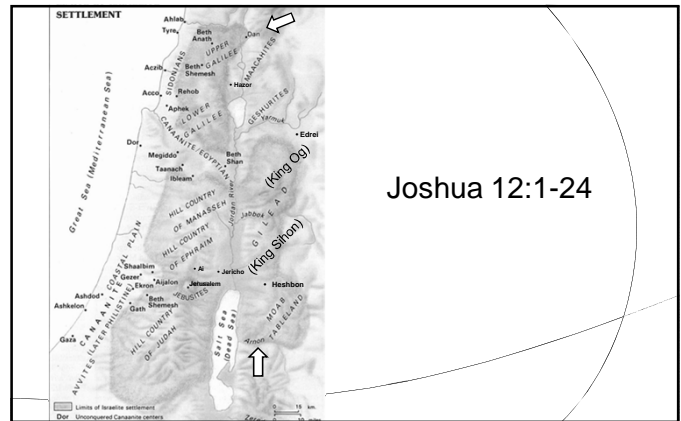


Inheriting the Land of Promise

Kingdom Typology

- 1.) The land of Canaan is a type of God's ultimate kingdom inheritance brought by Jesus; the land uniquely belongs to the Lord
- 2.) The Canaanites are a type of God's obstinate enemies who are opposed to God's kingdom purposes (c.f. Psalm 2)

Why are the nations in an uproar
And the peoples devising a vain thing?
2 The kings of the earth take their stand
And the rulers take counsel together
Against the LORD and against His Anointed, saying,
3 "Let us tear their fetters apart
And cast away their cords from us!"
4 He who sits in the heavens laughs,
The Lord scoffs at them.
5 Then He will speak to them in His anger
And terrify them in His fury, saying,
6 "But as for Me, I have installed My King
Upon Zion, My holy mountain."

Kingdom Typology

- 3.) The conquest of the kings of Canaan by Joshua and Israel is a type of God's ultimate triumph over His enemies through Jesus

*Colossians 2:15; 1 Corinthians 15:24-26;
Revelation 19:11-16*

Kingdom Typology

- Joshua 12 encourages us that through Christ God has defeated all our enemies and He will bring us safely into our inheritance

Itemized Worship

- *"count your blessings, name them one by one"*
 - itemizing God's goodness and works is the repeated method of God's people
 - reciting the specific mercies of God nurtures and encourages our faith
