Bible's Storyline

- 2. Fulfillment in Part: Joshua & Judges
 - > Joshua: inheriting the land of promise
 - the land was Yahweh's gracious gift
 - the battle belonged to Yahweh
 - Yahweh demanded exclusive loyalty

Bible's Storyline

- 2. Fulfillment in Part: Joshua & Judges
 - Judges: rebellion, ruin...and rescue
 - Israel's repeated enslavement to idolatry
 - Yahweh's burning anger against His people
 - Yahweh's commitment to deliver His people

Something Better...

- 1. The incompleteness of the land of Canaan
 - inheriting Canaan is not the fulfillment of the promise a picture of the final kingdom
 - the conquest of Canaan through holy war is a type of God's ultimate victory

Something Better...

- 2. The inadequacy of the Law-Covenant
 - it was inadequate to overcome the rebellion and idolatry of the heart
 - it was inadequate to achieve a lasting, final deliverance of God's people

Something Better...

- 3. The faithfulness of Yahweh...yet His wrath
 - Yahweh will not break His covenant-promise He made to Abraham
 - Yahweh's wrath is inevitable against covenant unfaithfulness

Something Better...

³⁹ And all these, having gained approval through their faith, did not receive what was promised, ⁴⁰ because God had provided something better for us, so that apart from us they would not be made perfect.

(Hebrews 11:39-40)
