They Were All of One Heart and Soul

When some believers saw other believers in need they sold their house or land.

- 1. Everyone didn't sell everything (still ownership in Acts 5:4; 12:12)
- 2. Rather, they did not claim the things they had to be their own.
- 3. This was ongoing, "from time to time" (NIV).
- 4. Not truly utopia, believers continue to sin (chs. 5-6)

They Were All of One Heart and Soul

Q: How did this happen?

A: Unity led them to generosity. And it was the gospel that created this unity. (v. 33)

Q: Why did this happen?

A: The promise of the gospel, that is, the guarantee of the Father's love, provides a sense of security that frees Christians from fear so they don't go looking for security elsewhere (Luke12:32-34).
