



The Power & Perversion of the Gospel

Power & Perversion

- 1. Power of the Gospel
 - strong cultural, religious barriers and prejudices are overcome through salvation in Jesus



Power & Perversion

- 1. Power of the Gospel
 - strong cultural, religious barriers and prejudices are overcome through salvation in Jesus
 - the gospel overcomes false religion based in demonic/occultic activity

Power & Perversion

- 2. Delay of the Spirit
 - the apostles came as a sign of fellowship and solidarity – affirmed that the Samaritans were part of the church
 - the reception of the Spirit is the undeniable evidence of salvation and inclusion into the community of believers

Power & Perversion

- 3. Reality of False Conversion
 - Simon had every outward appearance of being a Christian but his true, unconverted condition was exposed
 - Simon continued to crave power and recognition and saw Jesus as a means to both

Power & Perversion

- Lesson: there is a faith in Jesus that does not save
 - No acknowledgement of sin and guilt
 - No need of repentance
 - No love for the glory of Jesus as Savior and Lord
