The Gospel Encounters Rome

Encountering Rome

- 1. Encounter with the fortuneteller
 - Paul rejects convenient alliances with religious systems that are, at the heart, lies
 - the supremacy of the gospel is displayed in the immediate exorcism of this spirit

Encountering Rome

- 2. Encounter with cultural hostility
 - the personal and cultural implications and impact of the gospel will lead to hostility
 - rehearsing the greatness and goodness of God in the midst of suffering is a source of our comfort and confidence

Encountering Rome

- 3. Encounter with the Roman jailer
 - the earthquake and subsequent conversion of the jailer displays the progress of the gospel in the face of cultural opposition

Encountering Rome

- 3. Encounter with the Roman jailer
 - the essence of the gospel message is exhibited in the conversion of the jailer
 - the reality of his conversion is seen in his joy-filled, risk-taking care of the brethren

Encountering Rome

- 4. Encounter with the Roman magistrates
 - Paul's concern was with the public standing of the Christian mission and the protection of this young church
 - Paul's controlling principle of life: "I do all things for the sake of the gospel" (1 Cor. 9:23)
