Paul Versus Athens

- 2. What Paul Felt
 - his spirit was "provoked" an intense agitation or irritation in the face of idols
 - a zeal and jealousy for the honor and glory of God in Jesus Christ

Paul Versus Athens

- 3. What Paul Did
 - he proclaimed the good news of Jesus and the resurrection
 - he deliberately and directly engaged people with the gospel in the public square
