

For the Sake of the Gospel

- 1. Paul's continued and ongoing encouragement of believers
 - Paul understands the importance of focusing on people for the purpose of ministering to them
 - Paul makes the most of every opportunity for the sake of gospel ministry

For the Sake of the Gospel

- > Application
 - Do you prioritize being with people, especially for the sake of the Gospel?
 - Do you make the most of every opportunity?

For the Sake of the Gospel

- 2. Paul's resolve to go to Jerusalem in light of certain suffering
 - Q: In the face of suffering, why would Paul go?
 - To give the financial gift from the Gentile believers to relieve tension among the Jewish and Gentile believers (Romans 15:28)
 - For the sake of the spread of the Gospel, especially to unreached areas
