

Before Kings and Governors

Acts 22-26 teaches...

- 1. Christianity faces significant, unjust opposition
- 2. Christianity is no civil threat to just government
- 3. Christianity is the fulfillment of God's promises to Israel (not an aberrant sect)
- 4. God's providence in the progress of the gospel



Paul Before Felix

- 1. Paul's Accusers
 - · charged Paul with promoting sedition and unrest
 - · charged Paul with leading an illegal "sect"
 - charged Paul with trying to defile the temple

Paul Before Felix

- 2. Paul's Defense
 - · no evidence of Paul inciting a riot
 - "the Way" is not a sect but the fulfillment of the Law and the Prophets
 - · Paul did not defile the temple in any manner

Paul Before Felix

- 3. Paul's Witness
 - a) His message: faith in Christ Jesus
 - righteousness
 - · self-control
 - · judgment to come

Paul Before Felix

- 3. Paul's Witness
 - b) Felix's response
 - · initial conviction yet procrastination
 - · competing desires trumped gospel conviction
