Paul's Appeal

Paul's Example in Testifying to the Gospel

- 1. Paul's preparedness to proclaim Christ, regardless of audience or circumstance
 - Paul faces adversity from high authorities, but he remains fearless in his gospel proclamation
 - · Paul knows the message he is proclaiming

Paul's Example in Testifying to the Gospel

- 2. Paul's unwavering resolve to proclaim Christ
 - · His confidence in the truth of the gospel
 - · His understanding of his commission

Paul's Example in Testifying to the Gospel

- 3. Paul's heart for the lost
 - Paul uses every opportunity to proclaim Christ for the hope of salvation
 - Paul desires that all would meet Christ and trust in him for their salvation

Application from Paul's Example

- 1. Are you prepared to testify about the risen Messiah?
 - Do you know the Word? Do you spend time reading it and studying it?
 - Do you ask the Lord for boldness? Do you ask others to pray this on your behalf?

Application from Paul's Example

- 2. Are you willing to be considered mad for the sake of the gospel?
 - A life lived for the gospel's sake is madness to the world.
 - God delights in those who are "out of their mind" for the sake of the gospel

Application from Paul's Example

- 3. Is your heart broken for the lost?
 - Are you actively taking part in the sowing of the gospel seed?
 - Jesus is about saving the lost . . . are you?
