The Ending that is Not an End

Not the End...

- 1. The Hope of Israel
 - Israel had the promise of kingdom-resurrection hope to be brought by Messiah
 - Jesus, the risen Messiah, has brought this hope in fulfillment of the Scriptures

Not the End...

- 2. The Rejection by Israel
 - the majority of Jewish people rejected Jesus as Messiah because of their hardness of heart
 - as a result of their persistent unbelief, preaching the gospel results in God's judicial hardening

Not the End...

- 3. The Receptivity by the Gentiles
 - God has sent this salvation in Christ Jesus to the Gentiles who are now partakers of the promise given to Israel (cf. Eph. 3:6)
 - God promises receptivity and fruitfulness among the nations

Not the End...

- 4. The Triumph of the Gospel
 - though Paul is in chains, the gospel is proclaimed with boldness
 - though Paul is in chains, the gospel is proclaimed unhindered (cf. 2 Tim. 2:9)

Not the End...

- ➤ Luke's "conclusion" shows...
 - the gospel is the content of our proclamation and the unchanging task of Jesus' witnesses
 - the mission is not finished—the gospel advance must and will continue to all nations
