#### Why 1-2 Samuel?

- The deep conviction that "all Scripture is Godbreathed and profitable for teaching..." (2 Tim. 3:16)
- 2. To help us see the Bible's story the Bible is ultimately one book with one Author revealing one unfolding story.

#### The Bible's Story

Unifying Theme:

> The establishment of God's kingdom

God's people in God's place under God's rule and blessing (i.e. His presence)

#### The Bible's Story

- 1. Creation & Eden: pattern of the kingdom
- 2. Rebellion & Ruin
  - > cryptic promise (Gen. 3:15) "seed of the woman"
- 3. Central Promise: covenant with Abraham
  - ➤ "seed", "land", "blessing"

#### The Bible's Story

- 4. The Exodus: redemption from slavery
- 5. The Law Covenant: a holy nation
  - ➤ God dwelling with His people (tabernacle)
- 6. Inheritance of the Land: Yahweh's gift

#### The Bible's Story

- > A Dissonant Note
  - · Golden Calf at Sinai (Ex. 32)
  - Rebellion at Kadesh-Barnea (Num. 13-14)
  - Period of the Judges
