Restoration & Remembrance

- 1. Affliction and Sorrow
 - the Philistines affliction of Israel was a form of God's judgment due to Israel's idolatry
 - God's purpose in this affliction is their sorrow unto repentance

Restoration & Remembrance

- 2. Repentance and Renewal
 - repentance and exclusive worship is the condition for restoration and blessing
 - true repentance produces fruit forsaking other "gods"

Restoration & Remembrance

- 3. Victory and Blessing
 - the battle is the Lord's! He alone subdues all His enemies
 - His people are called to faithfulness to Him and His word

Who can stand before the Lord?

- > A Samuel-Like Intercessor
 - one who makes intercession for us on the basis on atonement
- ⁴ For it is impossible for the blood of bulls and goats to take away sins...¹² but He, having offered one sacrifice for sins for all time, SAT DOWN AT THE RIGHT HAND OF GOD,
- $^{\rm 13}$ waiting from that time onward until His enemies be MADE A FOOTSTOOL FOR HIS FEET.
- $^{\rm 14}\,\text{For}$ by one offering He has perfected for all time those who are sanctified.
