





## Rejected & Desperate Q: What is the point of this episode? To confirm the Lord's rejection of Saul in fulfillment of His word, and show Saul's hopeless condition as one rejected

## **Rejected & Desperate**

- 1. A Desperate Condition
  - Saul sought, not the Lord, but the Lord's guidance/favor for his own ends
  - Saul used what he knew was forbidden by the Lord as a means of hearing from the Lord!

# Rejected & Desperate Divination Prohibited act of rebellion – seeking guidance apart from the true God plays into the hands of the demonic

## **Rejected & Desperate**

- 2. An Unusual Means
  - the Lord allowed Samuel, though dead, to deliver a final word of judgment to Saul
  - the only instance in the Bible of contacting the dead results in a word of judgment from God's prophet

### **Rejected & Desperate**

- 3. A Hopeless Despair
  - though very afraid, Saul found no place for repentance
  - a meal was his only source of comfort before final disaster
