

### "Thus Saul Died..."

- 1. The Fulfillment of God's Word
  - ultimately the Lord killed Saul in fulfillment of His word of judgment against Saul
  - though He used wicked men as His means, God authored this "disaster"

## "Thus Saul Died..."

- Q: What about Jonathan?
  - Jonathan was faithful to the end, even in fighting the Philistines
  - Jonathan's death was not a judgment for any specific sin God had another purpose

#### "Thus Saul Died..."


- 2. The Disgrace of God's Name
  - the Philistine victory was viewed as the defeat of Yahweh by the Philistine gods
  - God allows His name to suffer reproach in bringing judgment on His people for their good and His glory


# "Thus Saul Died..."

- 2. The Disgrace of God's Name
  - the ultimate expression of this "disgrace" was the cross God's judgment for our good!

## "Thus Saul Died..."

- 3. The Death of a Tragic Life
  - · Saul died as he lived fearful and faithless
  - Saul had a good beginning, but it proved no guarantee of a good ending
