



David established as King!


- 1. He defeated the Philistines at Baal-Perazim ("the Lord of breakthrough")
- 2. He established Jerusalem as the capital, "the city of David"

¹⁵ When Aaron and his sons have finished covering the holy *objects* and all the furnishings of the sanctuary, when the camp is to set out, after that the sons of Kohath shall come to carry *them*, so that they will not touch the holy *objects* and die... ²⁰ but they shall not go in to see the holy *objects* even for a moment, or they will die." (Numbers 4:15, 20)

Danger & Delight 1. The Danger of Holiness God's holiness makes His presence with His people exceedingly dangerous/deadly! like David, we must fear the holiness of God before we delight in His mercy

Danger & Delight

- 2. The Delight of Worship
 - on the basis of atonement, there is peace and pleasure in the presence of God
 - there is no excess of devotion to or delight in the Lord, even for a king!
