⁹ I have been with you wherever you have gone and have cut off all your enemies from before you; and I will make you a great name, like the names of the great men who are on the earth.

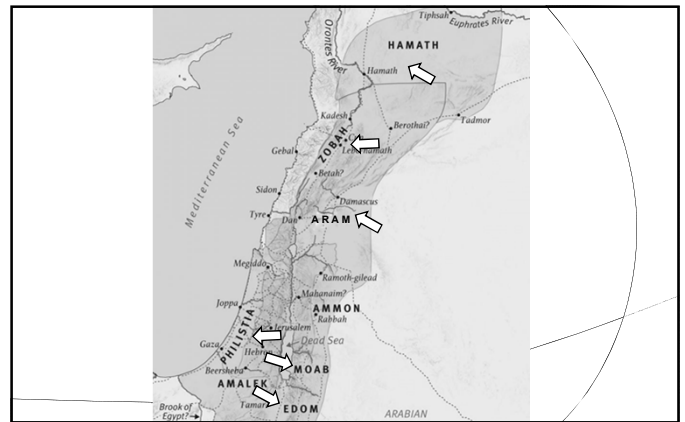

David's Great Kingdom



David's Great Kingdom

1. The subjugation of the nations by Yahweh and His anointed (cf. Psalm 2)
2. The faithfulness and devotion of David as a warrior
3. The justice and righteousness of David as the king

Messiah's Greater Kingdom

- Messiah's kingdom is established by warfare and subjugation of His enemies

Messiah's Greater Kingdom

1. By His death and resurrection Jesus triumphs over God's enemies (Col. 2:12-15)
 - Satan and spiritual forces are defeated by Christ's atoning death
 - in Christ enemies die under God's judgment and are raised to new life

Messiah's Greater Kingdom

2. Jesus will come as a warrior to establish His everlasting kingdom
 - He will destroy forever those who persist in rebellion (Rev. 19:11-21)
 - He will establish forever under His righteous reign those who belong to Him
