



Consequences Continued...

- 1. Amnon's Unbridled Perversion
 - a replication of David's sin lust, deceit, and sexual immorality
 - an uncontrolled, all-consuming lust that led to rape, incest and hatred

Consequences Continued...

Warning: the destruction that results from unbridled lusts

Consequences Continued...

- 2. David's Inexcusable Inaction
 - David seems to have lost his moral authority and courage due to his own sin
 - David's inaction with Amnon led to greater sin and devastation in his family

Consequences Continued... Warning: the danger of indulging sin in the church and in our children in the church (1 Cor. 5:1-13) in our children (Prov. 19:18; 23:14-15)

Consequences Continued...

- 3. Absalom's Calculated Revenge
 - a replication of David's sin deceptive, planned murder by the hands of others
 - · David appeared weak, indecisive and inept

Consequences Continued...

 Warning: the strong temptation towards revenge and the destruction it brings (Rom. 12:17-21)

Consequences Continued...

- > Overarching Lessons:
 - 1. Be sobered by the devastating consequences of sin (2 Sam. 12:10-11)
 - 2. Be encouraged that sin's consequences are the Father's loving discipline for our good (Psalm 89:30-34; Heb. 12:10)
