

#### Wrath, Atonement & the King

- 1. David's Sin
  - it was "incited" by Yahweh as an occasion for bringing judgment on Israel
  - we are not told why numbering the people was a great evil (can only imply it)

### Wrath, Atonement & the King

- 2. David's Repentance
  - he saw his sin as a great evil and repented without being confronted
  - he trusted in the Lord's mercy even in the midst of His wrath

# Wrath, Atonement & the King

- 3. David's Intercession
  - David asked to receive the Lord's judgment instead of the people
  - David offered sacrifices of atonement at his own expense to remove God's wrath

### Wrath, Atonement & the King

- > Pointing to King Jesus...
  - 1. The Intercession of the King
    - the willingness to bear the wrath of God instead of His sheep
    - the offer of atonement at great cost to Himself to remove God's wrath

## Wrath, Atonement & the King

- ➤ Pointing to King Jesus...
  - 2. The place of atonement
    - this threshing floor became the site of the future temple
    - Mt. Moriah where Abraham was to offer Isaac ("Yahweh will provide")
