- ➤ The saving reign of God must be mediated through a human king
- What will this king be like? Not Saul-like but David-like

Samuel...From Song to Song

- First Song: Hannah envisions God's king bringing about a great reversal
- Last Song: David embodies and fulfills Hannah's song...but not perfectly

2 Samuel 23:1-7

The Last Words of David

Now these are the last words of David.

David the son of Jesse declares,

The man who was raised on high declares,

The anointed of the God of Jacob,

And the sweet psalmist of Israel,

2 "The Spirit of the LORD spoke by me,

And His word was on my tongue.

3 "The God of Israel said,

The Rock of Israel spoke to me,

'He who rules over men righteously,

'He who rules over men righteously,
Who rules in the fear of God,

4 Is as the light of the morning when the sun rises,
A morning without clouds,
When the tender grosses, without of the contri

A morning without clouds, When the tender grass springs out of the earth, Through sunshine after rain.'

5 "Truly is not my house so with God?

6 "But the worthless, every one of them

Final Words

- 1. A Sure Word
 - "oracle" of David the revealed (prophetic) nature of David's words
 - David's last words were the Lord's infallible words to him

Final Words

- 2. An Ideal King
 - a king who rules righteously in the fear of God will bring unbounded flourishing
 - a declaration of final Davidic king who rules over all men – King Jesus!

Final Words

- 3. An Enduring House
 - the final, ideal, eternal king will be from the house of David (cf. 7:12-16)
 - David's hope and salvation was secured in this promise

Final Words

- 4. A Final Judgment
 - those who resist the rule of God's anointed King will be destroyed (cf. Psalm 2)
 - · the King himself will be the judge
