The Gospel of God

<sup>25</sup> who (Jesus) was delivered up for of our transgressions, and was raised for of our justification.

(Romans 4:25)

#### Essence of the Gospel

- Context
  - Paul defends justification by faith alone by the example of Abraham
  - Not a generic faith but faith in the promise and work of God now fulfilled in Jesus
  - Paul concludes by restating the basis of our justification – the death and resurrection of Jesus

### Essence of the Gospel

- 1. Jesus was "handed over for our transgressions"
  - it was God the Father who handed Jesus over to death for us (cf. Rom. 8:32)
  - Jesus' death was the penalty of God's just retribution for our sin (cf. Rom. 3:25)

# Essence of the Gospel

- 2. Jesus was "raised for our justification"
  - A. Righteousness of God
    - as ruler and judge of the earth, God acts to restore right order in His good creation
    - includes both his saving activity and his retributive justice (salvation through judgment)
    - not merely the pronouncement of justice but the enactment of justice

# Essence of the Gospel

- 2. Jesus was "raised for our justification"
  - B. Justification of Sinners
    - a verdict (declared righteous) expressed in a vindicating action

- <sup>14</sup> "In righteousness you will be established; You will be far from oppression, for you will not fear; And from terror, for it will not come near you.
- <sup>15</sup> "If anyone fiercely assails *you* it will not be from Me. Whoever assails you will fall because of you.
- <sup>16</sup> "Behold, I Myself have created the smith who blows the fire of coals and brings out a weapon for its work; And I have created the destroyer to ruin.
- <sup>17</sup> "No weapon that is formed against you will prosper; And every tongue that accuses you in judgment you will condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the LORD, And their <u>vindication</u> is from Me," declares the LORD.

(Isaiah 54:14-17)

# Essence of the Gospel

- 2. Jesus was "raised for our justification"
  - B. Justification of Sinners
    - a verdict (declared righteous) expressed in a vindicating action
    - it entails deliverance and life the enactment of the verdict in our resurrection

### Essence of the Gospel

- 2. Jesus was "raised for our justification"
  - C. Resurrection of Jesus
    - Christ's resurrection is the vindicating act of God in which He is justified and we are justified
    - God's verdict for us is present and manifest in the resurrection of Jesus

# Essence of the Gospel

The essence of the gospel is the death <u>AND</u> resurrection of Jesus – the gift of God's righteousness by faith alone
