Romans 6:23

"For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord."

²⁰ For when you were slaves of sin, you were free in regard to righteousness.

²¹ Therefore what fruit did you have then? That of which you are now ashamed. For the outcome of those things is death.
²² But now having been freed from sin and enslaved to God,

you have your fruit, leading to sanctification, and the outcome, eternal life.

Romans 6:23

- Three Contrasts
 - 1. Two Masters: Sin or God
 - · Sin is a master who pays wages
 - · God is a master who gives gifts

Romans 6:23

- Three Contrasts
 - 2. Two Means: Wages or Gift
 - "wages" are something you earn and deserve according to works
 - a "gift" is something you do not and cannot earn or deserve according to grace

⁴ Now to the one who works, his wage is not credited according to grace, but according to what is due. ⁵ But to the one who does not work, but believes in Him who justifies the ungodly, his faith is credited as righteousness.

Romans 6:23

- Three Contrasts
 - 3. Two Outcomes: Death and Eternal Life
 - "death" final and irreversible separation from God under His judgment
 - "life eternal" sharing and enjoying the life of God in the new creation

Romans 6:23

- > One Foundation: "in Christ Jesus our Lord"
 - this gift of God's grace is entirely and exclusively in and through Christ Jesus
 - the death and resurrection of Christ are the only grounds for the gift of life
