### The Book of Romans

The Gospel of God

<sup>25</sup> For I do not want you, brethren, to be uninformed of this mystery—so that you will not be wise in your own estimation—that a partial hardening has happened to Israel until the fullness of the Gentiles has come in;

<sup>26</sup> and thus all Israel will be saved; just as it is written, "THE DELIVERER WILL COME FROM ZION, HE WILL REMOVE UNGODLINESS FROM JACOB."
<sup>27</sup> "THIS IS MY COVENANT WITH THEM,

WHEN I TAKE AWAY THEIR SINS." <sup>28</sup> From the standpoint of the gospel they are enemies for your sake, but from the standpoint of election they are beloved for the sake of the fathers; <sup>29</sup> for the gifts and the calling of God are irrevocable.

 $^{\rm 30}\,{\rm For}$  just as you once were disobedient to God, but now have been shown mercy because of their disobedience,

 $^{\rm 31}\,\rm so$  these also now have been disobedient, that because of the mercy shown to you they also may now be shown mercy.

 $^{32}\,\mbox{For}$  God has shut up all in disobedience so that He may show mercy to all.

(Romans 11:25-32)

#### This Mystery...

- > something hidden from God's people in the past but now revealed in the gospel
  - concerns the sequence of salvation-history that culminates in Israel's salvation
  - Paul wants us (Gentiles) to know it in order to keep us from pride and a sense of superiority

#### This Mystery...

- 1. "Partial Hardening" of Israel
  - the judicial act of God that renders Israel spiritually insensitive and incapable of responding to God
  - "in part" not total; there remains a remnant as a sign of hope of restoration
  - temporary this partial hardening is only "until" the fullness of the Gentiles comes in

#### This Mystery...

- 2. "The fullness of the Gentiles"
  - the full or complete number of Gentiles entering the kingdom of God (salvation)
  - implies that Israel's hardening will be removed when this "fullness" has been completed

# This Mystery...

3. "All Israel Will Be Saved"

### What does "all Israel" mean?

- > Three views
  - 1. The true, "spiritual" Israel consisting of both Jews and Gentiles throughout history
  - 2. The total number of elect Israelites throughout history (the real Israel; the remnant; c.f. 9:6)
  - 3. The nation of Israel as a whole (corporate entity); the mass of Israel in contrast to the remnant

# This Mystery...

- 3. "All Israel Will Be Saved"
  - the future salvation of the nation of Israel as a whole (their "fullness"/"acceptance")
  - this salvation of Israel will be accomplished by Christ in connection with His coming – He will remove their ungodliness
