Hymn of Praise to God

- > Introduction
 - The unfolding of God's scheme of salvation-history to magnify His mercy is what most directly leads Paul to this hymn of praise
 - 2) This hymn is an expression of wonder and adoration at the revelation of God's unfathomable ways

Hymn of Praise to God

- 1. Astonished Exclamation
 - at the inexhaustible magnitude ("depth") of God's riches, wisdom and knowledge
 - at the unfathomableness of God's decisions and actions in salvation history

Hymn of Praise to God

- 2. Rhetorical Questions
 - these emphasize that God, as Creator, stands infinitely above and beyond his creatures (mankind)
 - God is no one's debtor He always acts freely in the giving of His mercy (no merit)

Hymn of Praise to God

- 3. Foundational Affirmation
 - God is the source, the sustainer and the goal of everything!
 - The chief end in the design of all creation and history is the glory of God
