


The Gospel of God

Foundation of NT Ethics

- 1. The Command
 - resist the process of being molded and fashioned into the behaviors and values of this present age
 - allow the Holy Spirit to continually change us into conformity with the behaviors and values of the new age

Foundation of NT Ethics

- 2. The Means
 - ➤ "by the renewing of the mind"
 - cultivate the mindset that accords with the values and beliefs of the new age (c.f. Eph. 4:22-24)
 - fill your mind with Bible-saturated, Christ-centered truth, and pray for Spirit-produced love and humility

Foundation of NT Ethics

- 3. The Purpose
 - to discern and approve what God wants of us with a view to putting it into practice
 - in order that we might know what we are to do to please God in any situation

Foundation of NT Ethics

- > Discerning the will of God
 - not insight into God's perfect plan for your life, but behavior that pleases Him in every action
 - not knowledge apart from the Bible, but the approval and application of it in all circumstances
 - not by the Law but walking by the Spirit according to the rule of love
