Gospel Summary:

The justification of God in the justification of the ungodly by faith alone in Christ alone

Soli Deo Gloria!

- 1. God has consigned all under sin
 - all humanity is under the power of sin and the indictment of God's just judgment (3:9; 3:19)
 - God is justified in His judgment and triumph over His enemies (3:4-8)
 - Israel is consigned to disobedience that they might receive mercy...to the glory of God! (11:32)

Soli Deo Gloria!

 33 Oh, the depth of the riches and the wisdom and the knowledge of God! How unsearchable are His judgments and unfathomable His ways! 34 For WHO HAS KNOWN THE MIND OF THE LORD, OR WHO BECAME HIS COUNSELOR? 35 Or WHO HAS FIRST GIVEN TO HIM THAT IT MIGHT BE PAID BACK TO HIM AGAIN? 36 For from Him and through Him and to Him are all things. To Him *be* the glory forever. Amen.

(Romans 11:33-36)

Soli Deo Gloria!

- 2. Christ delivers us by His death and resurrection
 - God executed His just wrath against us in the death of Jesus, and secured our justification in His resurrection (3:24-25; 4:25)
 - God is both just and the justifier of the ungodly (3:26)

Soli Deo Gloria!

- 3. God justifies us by faith alone in Christ alone
 - "justified" God's saving justice has been granted to us both as a *verdict* ("not guilty") and *vindication* (final transformation) (3:22-24)

Soli Deo Gloria!

- 3. God justifies us by faith alone in Christ alone
 - faith accords with grace/mercy; it is "not working" but trusting alone in God's work and promise (4:4-5; 16; 11:5-6)
 - faith alone excludes all human boasting; God alone is exalted in His mercy (3:27; 4:20-21)
