Paul's Use of Baptism

- 1. Synonym for conversion/salvation
 - Christians are those "who have been baptized into Christ Jesus"
 - baptism is always the decisive, outward way of responding to the gospel

Paul's Use of Baptism

- 2. Instrument of union with Christ
 - through baptism we participate with Christ in His own death and burial
 - we are raised to "newness of life" in union with the resurrection of Christ

Immersion into water in the name of Christ (baptism) portrays our death, burial and resurrection with Christ
