- A. Three Overall Effects:
 - 1. Shows the rapid, predictable, downward spiral into idolatry
 - this is the human condition on display! (cf. Rom. 1:25)

- A. Three Overall Effects:
 - 2. Displays the instability, violence, and evil of a nation given to idolatry
 - this is the judgment of God on display! (cf. Rom. 1:28-32)

 $^{28}\,\mathrm{And}$ just as they did not see fit to acknowledge God any longer, God gave them over to a depraved mind, to do those things which are not proper, 29 being filled with all unrighteousness, wickedness, greed, evil; full of envy, murder, strife, deceit, malice; they are gossips, 30 slanderers, haters of God, insolent, arrogant, boastful, inventors of evil, disobedient to parents, 31 without understanding, untrustworthy, unloving, unmerciful; 32 and although they know the ordinance of God, that those who practice such things are worthy of death, they not only do the same, but also give hearty approval to those who practice them.

 - 3. Focuses on what is most important the king's relationship to Yahweh
 - this is a wasted life on display!

- B. One Outstanding Feature:
 - ➤ "The Word of Yahweh"
 - · the word of the Lord controls these evil, violent events (15:29; 16:12)
 - God's uses evil for His purposes, yet holds people accountable for evil (16:7)
