

1 Kings 18:1-20

- 1. Elijah, Obadiah & Ahab
 - the Lord has His man inside the court quietly subverting Jezebel's agenda
 - Ahab has "troubled" Israel the drought is the Lord's judgment for covenant unfaithfulness

1 Kings 18:21-40

- 2. Elijah, Israel & the Prophets of Baal
 - the contest is to press the people to choose between Yahweh and Baal
 - Elijah orders the events in a way that will most display Baal's impotence and Yahweh's power
 - Israel's new commitment is tested by seizing and killing the prophets of Baal


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
1 Kings 18:41-46

3. Elijah, Ahab and the Promised Rain

- renewed covenant commitments lead to renewed covenant blessings (rain) – but not apart from Elijah's prayer
- this covenant renewal restores right order of king and prophet

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Implications

- 1. The Lord acts to vindicate His Name as the only and true God
- 2. If Yahweh is God, then follow Him alone with all your heart, mind and strength through Christ alone

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
