2 Kings 4:1-44

The agents of death experienced by the Lord's people in an idolatrous land are conquered by Yahweh's agent of life

2 Kings 4:1-44

- 1. The Presence of a Faithful Remnant
 - this is in keeping with the Lord's promise to Elijah (cf. 1 Kings 19:18)
 - four examples of a "living faith" in the midst of an idolatrous nation

2 Kings 4:1-44

- 1. The Presence of a Faithful Remnant
 - Elisha is the focal point of God's presence for this faithful remnant

2 Kings 4:1-44

- 2. The Extraordinary Provision of Life
 - examples of God's provision of the ordinary for ordinary, nameless people
 - displays the Lord's ultimate provision of life over death

2 Kings 4:1-44

- 2. The Extraordinary Provision of Life
 - these are previews of God's ultimate, unending provision in the final kingdom

2 Kings 4:1-44

- 3. The Prefiguring of Jesus
 - water to wine, raised the widow's son, fed five thousand with a few loaves...leftovers!
 - He is God come in the flesh the source of true life and final victory
