






BLACK OBELISK Assyrian King Shalmaneser III (reigned 858–824 в.с.).

• contrast the fate of those loyal to Ahab and those loyal to Yahweh

2 Kings 10:1-36

Scene Three: House of Baal (v.18-28)

 Jehu completes what Elijah had begun – the elimination of Baal worship from Israel

2 Kings 10:1-36

- Evaluating Jehu (v.29-36)
 - Jehu is commended and rewarded by the Lord for all that he did to the house of Ahab
 - Jehu is disapproved for maintaining a more subtle form of idolatry and not following the Lord with all his heart

2 Kings 10:1-36

- Application
 - beware of an outward "zeal" for the Lord that masks a divided, idolatrous heart
 - do not trust in man, but in the perfect man, Christ Jesus – a much better King!
