**2 Kings 19:1-37**

- *Displays God’s deliverance of His people for the sake of His name*
  - the Lord acts to vindicate His name as the only and true God
  - the Lord’s vindication of His name is bound up with the salvation of His people

## Why Trust Yahweh?

1. Because He is sovereign
  - He rules over and directs the affairs of all nations to accomplish His purposes
  - He works all things after the counsel of His will to bring about His saving purposes “to the praise of His glory” (cf. Eph. 1:11)

## Why Trust Yahweh?

2. Because He responds to our prayers
  - God has ordained to often make the prayers of His people the cause of His actions
  - In our need and petitions, ask God to work for the sake of His name

## Psalm 113

<sup>1</sup> Praise the LORD!  
 Praise, O servants of the LORD,  
 Praise the name of the LORD.  
<sup>2</sup> Blessed be the name of the LORD  
 From this time forth and forever.  
<sup>3</sup> From the rising of the sun to its setting  
 The name of the LORD is to be praised.  
<sup>4</sup> The LORD is high above all nations;  
 His glory is above the heavens.  
<sup>5</sup> Who is like the LORD our God,  
 Who is enthroned on high,

<sup>6</sup> Who humbles Himself to behold  
*The things that are* in heaven and in the earth?
