### Acts and the Early Church

- 1. Role of the Apostles
  - > Acts 1:12-26
    - they were teachers (2:42), leaders of the church (4:25), witnesses of the resurrection (4:20; 5:32) (e.g. the appointment of the seven 6:1-7)
    - the ministry of the Apostle Paul and his co-workers (Acts 13-28)

# Acts and the Early Church

- 2. Role of Elders
  - > Acts 14:21-23; 20:28
  - these men were the overseers, teachers and shepherds of local churches (c.f. 1 Peter 5:1-5)
  - they must exemplify godly character and the ability to teach sound doctrine (1 Timothy 3:1-7; Titus 1:5-9)

# Acts and the Early Church

- 3. Role of Women
  - women are seen as active participants in the church's life and witness
  - Lydia (Acts 16:13-15) an unmarried business woman who hosted the church in Philippi

### Acts and the Early Church

- 3. Role of Women
  - women are seen as active participants in the church's life and witness
  - Priscilla (and Aquila) (Acts 18:2-3, 26) a married couple who were bi-vocational co-workers of Paul, instrumental in the churches at Corinth, Ephesus and Rome

# Acts and the Early Church

- 3. Role of Women
  - women are seen as active participants in the church's life and witness
    - Phoebe (Rom. 16:1-2) an unmarried "servant" of the church who was a helper (patron) of many, including Paul

#### Galatians 3:28

<sup>26</sup> For you are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus.
<sup>27</sup> For all of you who were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ.
<sup>28</sup> There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free man, there is neither male nor female; for you are all one in Christ Jesus.
<sup>29</sup> And if you belong to Christ, then you are Abraham's descendants, heirs according to promise.

#### Galatians 3:28

- > Spiritual status in Christ (not gender roles)
  - through faith in Christ, all—regardless of race, class or gender—inherit the promise (salvation)
  - there is a spiritual unity ("one") in Christ amidst racial, socioeconomic and gender diversity
