Boasting about Tomorrow

- 1. Identifying subtle pride: confidence in our plans (v.13)
- 2. Reality check: you are not in control (v.14)
- 3. Alternative instructions: acknowledge God (v.15)
- 4. A sober warning: self-confidence is boasting before God (vv.16-17)
