Warning Against Apostasy

This warning is written to Christians as a means of our perseverance in faith and obedience

Warning Against Apostasy

- 1. The Nature of Apostasy
 - a) An ongoing, willful "sinning"
 - a willful, persistent neglect of what Christ has provided that results in apostasy
 - it is comparable to rejecting the law of Moses by means of willful idolatry (cf. Deut. 17:2-6)

Warning Against Apostasy

- 1. The Nature of Apostasy
 - b) A complete repudiation of Christ
 - · to show great disdain for the Son of God
 - · to regard His sacrifice as common, thus unholy
 - · to show arrogant disrespect for the Spirit

Warning Against Apostasy

- 2. The Outcome of Apostasy
 - no remedy, recourse or hope for the forgiveness of sins (no sacrifice for sin remains)
 - the terrifying reality of God's just judgment and vengeance worse than death itself

Warning Against Apostasy

- Take heed and take comfort!
 - allow the force of this warning to arouse us to take heed and continue to hold fast to Christ
 - if you take heed to this warning, take comfort that you have not committed this sin
